



## WHITETAIL HUNT SUGGESTED EQUIPMENT LIST

- Hunting license (if hunting in Texas)
- *Although not required, we recommend that you consider snake protection equipment such as snake chaps or snake boots (available at Cabela's)*
- Bolt action .270 caliber or larger rifle with sling, and scope and ammunition (not ballistic tip). Rifle sighted in (1) inch high at 100 yards
- Good quality binoculars; Spotting scope (if desired)
- All-weather camouflage gear for a wide temperature variation: shirt, jacket, pants, hat, head and face net, long underwear. We have had 75 degree temperatures one afternoon, with an overnight drop into the low 20's.
- Ear protection
- Rain gear
- Good quality hunting boots- not heavy
- Sunglasses and sunblock
- Large ice chest to transport game home if desired/duct tape/ID tags
- Shaving kit/personals
- Casual shoes for around camp, casual camp clothes
- Camera, film, and video camera
- Towels, shampoo, soap, linens and pillows are provided.

Every hunter (including out-of-state hunters) born on or after Sept. 2, 1971, must successfully complete a Hunter Education Training Course. Minimum age of certification is 12 years.

If you were born on or after September 2, 1971 and you are:

- under 12 years of age, you must be **accompanied\***.
- age 12 through 16, you must successfully complete a hunter education course, or you must be **accompanied\***.
- age 17 and over, you must successfully complete a hunter education course; or purchase a "Hunter Education Deferral," and you must be **accompanied\***.

\* **Accompanied** means: By a person who is at least 17, who is licensed to hunt in Texas, who has passed hunter education or is exempt (born before Sept. 2, 1971), and you must be within normal voice control. Proof of certification or deferral is required to be on your person while hunting. Note: Certification is not required to purchase a hunting license.
